At the time of an election, if and only if the number of interested candidates is greater than the available open board positions, then any Board of Director who has served at least two consecutive terms becomes ineligible to stay on the Board for a minimum of one-term (two years) before becoming eligible again. If there are not enough interested candidates to serve on open Board of Director positions, then any existing Board member may continue irrespective of the number of years they have served earlier. This law ensures that in the event there are not enough interested candidates to serve as Board of Director at any time, then an existing Board of Director can continue to serve the community.
